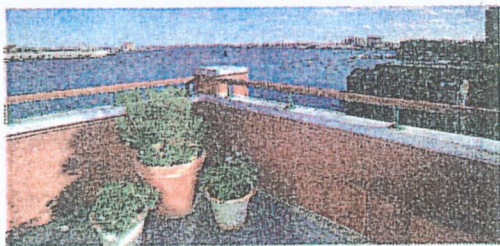

Overflowing with luxury



US Secretary of Energy **Samuel Bodman's** 4,500-square-foot penthouse on Burroughs Wharf is on the market for **\$9.25 million**. Carmella Laurella of Otis & Ahearn has the listing for the four-bedroom, six-bath condo. The waterfront penthouse has two private decks, three balconies, two built-in aquariums, two fireplaces, and two wet bars. The unit comes with three deeded parking spaces and a deeded marina slip, as well as a stunning view of Boston Harbor.

Bodman has been energy secretary since February 2005, and previously was a deputy secretary at both the Treasury and Commerce departments. A former president and chief operating officer of Fidelity Investments, Bodman is also former chairman and chief executive of Boston-based Cabot Corp. He started his career as an associate professor of chemical engineering at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, and has served as a trustee at the Isabella Stewart Gardner Museum and the New England Aquarium.
